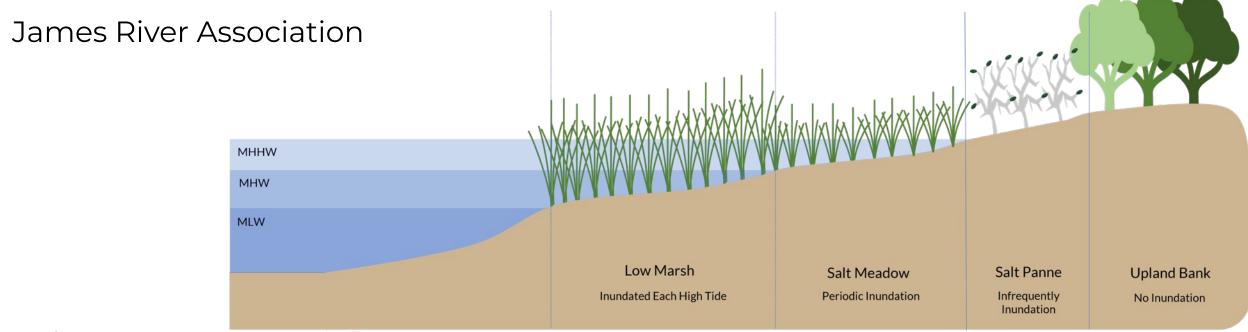

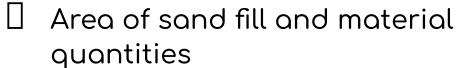




Elements to Include in Design

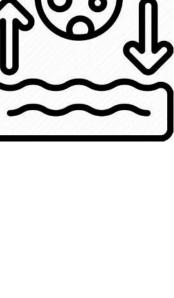

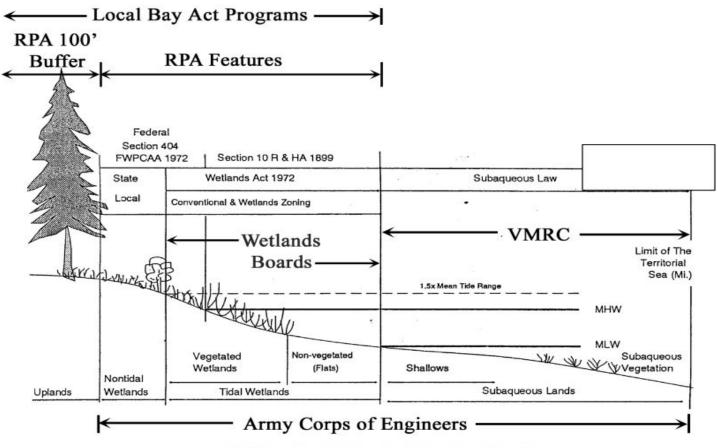




Jurisdictional Boundaries

Limiting Factors

- Access
- Muddy sediments
- Surrounding vegetation-Invasives
- Trees and Shade
- Elevation and Scour
- Outfalls or Dredged Canals
- Riparian Ownership
- Neighboring properties

Advantages

- Existing marsh
- Moderate to minimal erosion and wave activity
- Shallow water depth near the shoreline
- Abundant sunlight
- Sandy bottom
- Existing Oyster and Ribbed Mussel recruitment

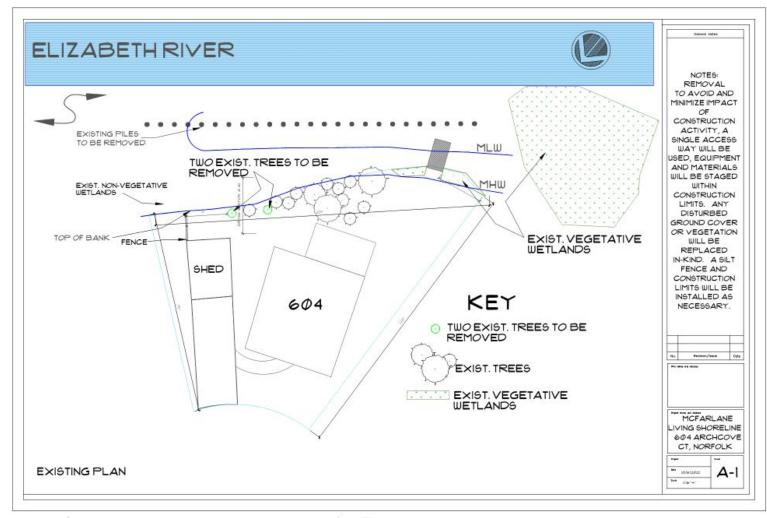


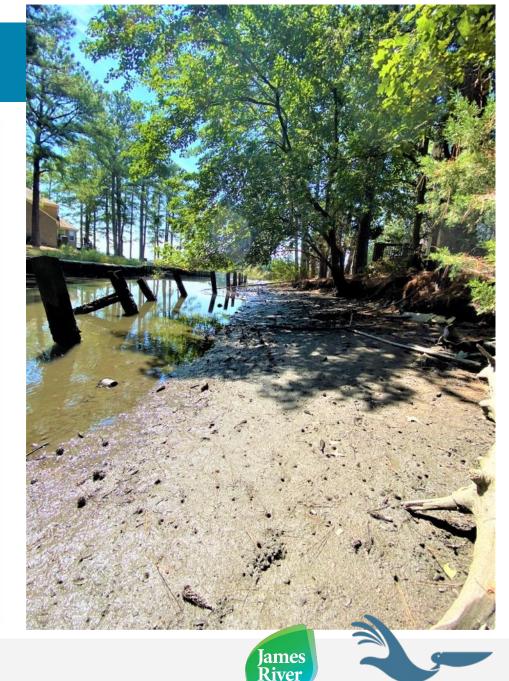






Existing and Proposed Design

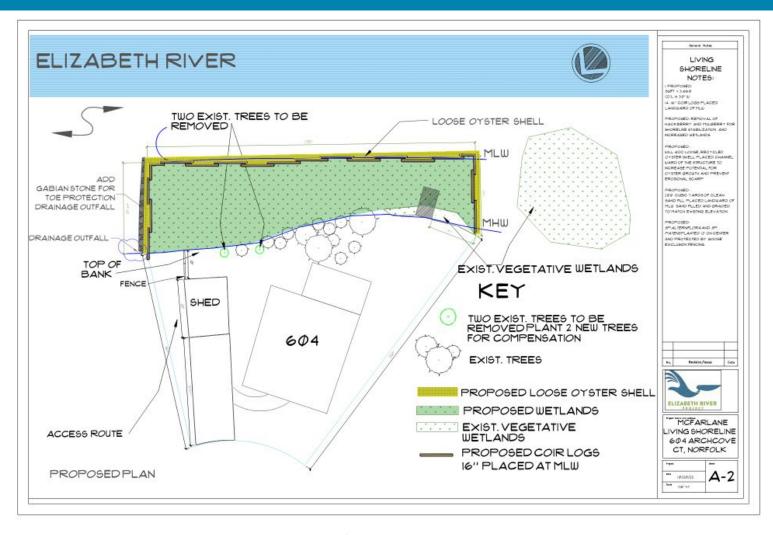








Existing and Proposed Design



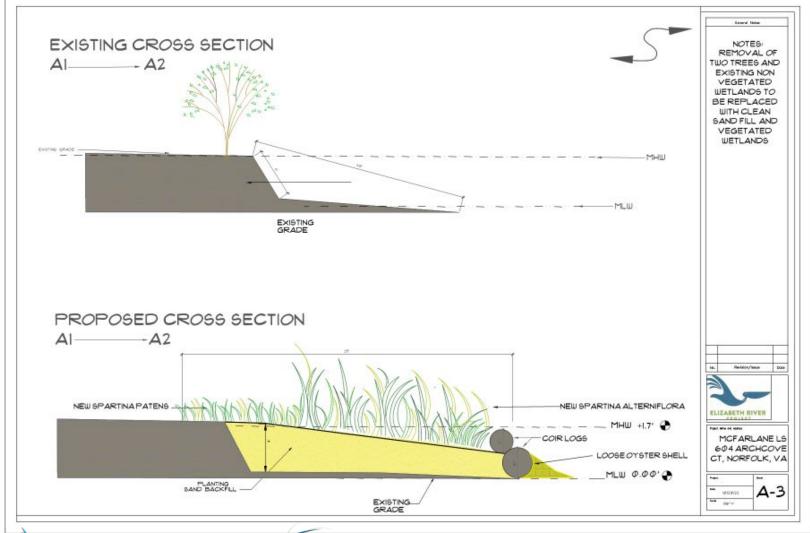








Cross-section & Elevation

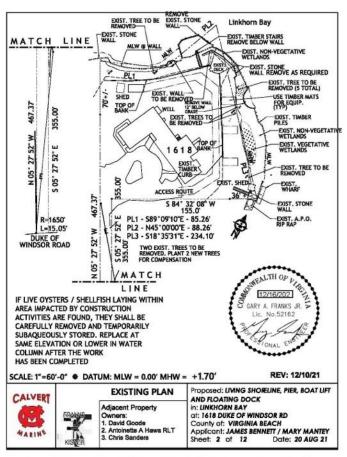

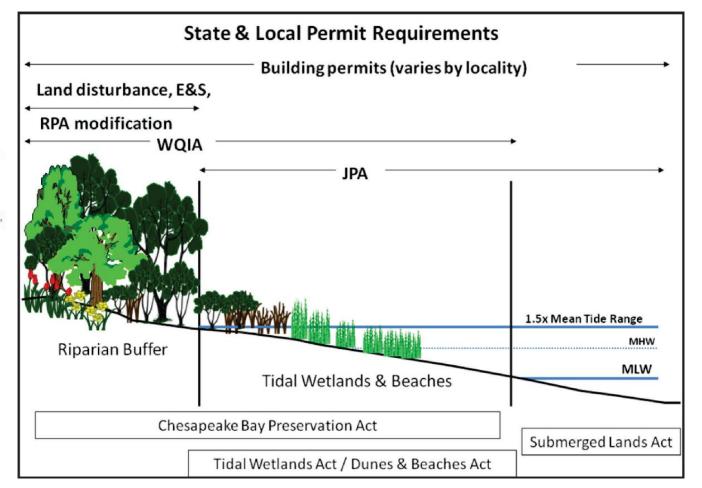
Encroachment & Construction Notes

NOTES:

- THE CONSTRUCTION ACCESS ROUTE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC & MATERIALS SHALL BE DELINEATED WITH SAFETY FENCE.
- ALL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROLS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AND MAINTAINED AS REQUIRED BY THE CITY OF VIRGINIA BEACH.
- 3, THE PROPERTY OWNERS ARE IDENTIFIED ON THE PROPERTY MAP, SHEET 1,
- ALL SILT FENCES SHALL BE WIRE REINFORCED, EMBEDDED 4" BELOW GRADE & SHALL BE 36" TALL.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE PROPERTY LINES IN THE FIELD TO ASSURE THAT THE IMPROVEMENTS SHOWN ARE WITHIN THE OWNER'S PROPERTY, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO VERIFY THE LAYOUT, ALIGNMENT AND GRADES PRIOR TO THE START OF WORK.
- GRANITE SHALL BE CLASS 1 GRANITE MIXED WITH CLASS A1, THE CONTRACTOR CAN USE RECYCLED CONCRETE OR THE EXISTING RIP RAP FOR THE BASE COURSE OF THE NEW REVETEMENT BUT THIS MATERIAL SHALL NOT BE EXPOSED. THE RECYCLED CONCRETE SHALL BE OF THE SAME SIZE AND WEIGHT AS THE GRANITE SPECIED.
- FILTER CLOTH SHALL BE PLACED UNDER GRANITE AS SHOWN.
- 8, ANY EXCESS CONCRETE RIP RAP AND OR DEBRIS SHALL BE LEGALLY DISPOSED OFF SITE,
- THESE PLANS ARE FOR PERMIT PURPOSES ONLY, NO GEOTECHNICAL OR STRUCTURAL BORINGS HAVE TAKEN PLACE AT THIS SITE, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE SOIL CONDITIONS TO BE SUITABLE.
- IF UNSUITABLE SOILS ARE ENCOUNTERED CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE OWNER AND CALVERT MARINE.

Construction Notes

- 1. Wetlands grasses will be installed on 12-inch centers.
- 2. Plant mortality will be addressed by replacing plants during the next available growing season.
- 3. Wetland planting will achieve an 85% coverage within two full growing seasons to be considered successful.
- 4. Oyster castles shall be stacked three high.
- 5. Sand shall be Vulcan White Sand # 31152.
- 6. Construction access route will be protected by timber mats and will be reseeded following construction.
- 7. All existing oysters will be hand harvested and placed in front of castles.



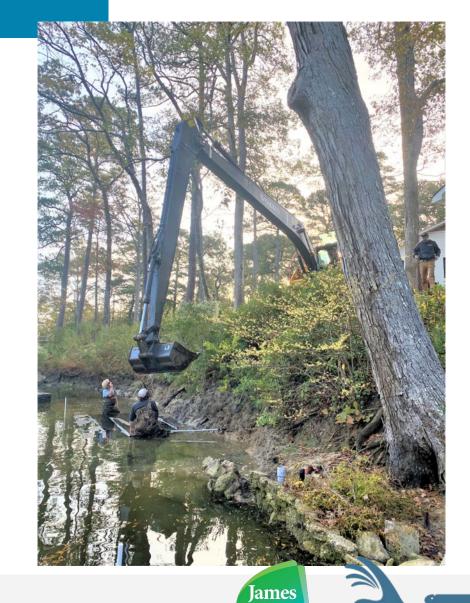






Rip Rap Sill Virginia Beach

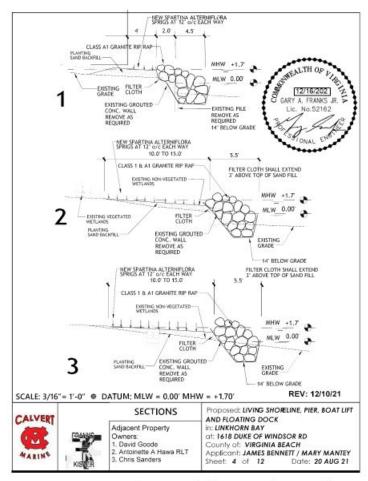

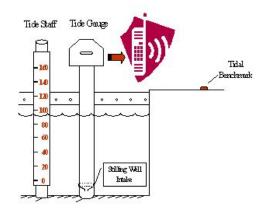

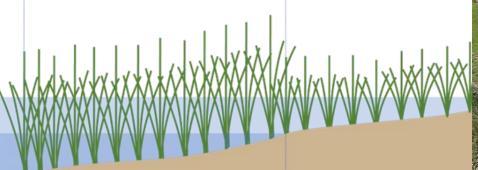


Tide Gauge

Salt Meadow Periodic Inundation







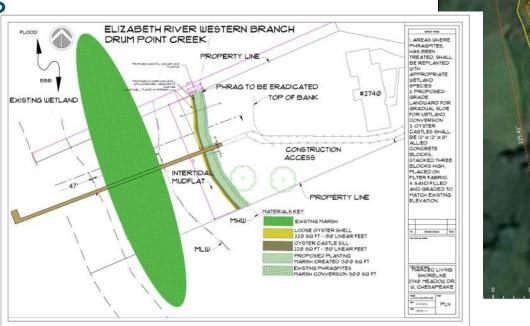


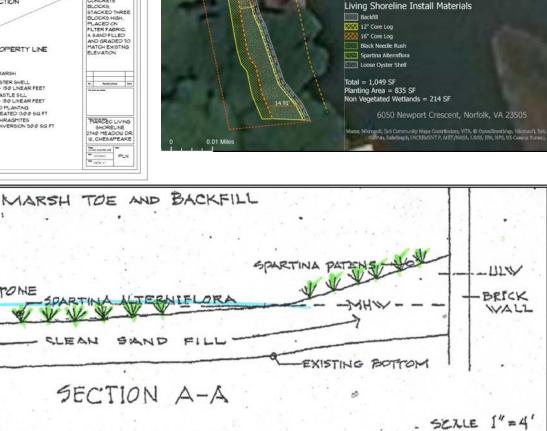


Tools For Design
